

Evaluation of Teacher Grant Applications  
Review Criteria  
For Grant Review Committee Members

Grant I. D. Number	Score (1 to 3 with 3 being the highest)
Did the teacher submit a complete application that is presented in a professional way?	
Does the teacher succinctly and clearly describe the project in the Project Summary?	
Does the teacher make a clear case for the needs for or advantages of the project or technology equipment?	
What is the potential for making significant positive impact on student achievement? (If the needs are adequately addressed, will they have significant impact on student achievement; or, if the enrichment is obtained, will it have significant impact on student achievement?)	
Does the teacher clearly describe the proposed activities?	
Is there a timeline that is realistic?	
Does the teacher have a realistic and appropriate evaluation method in mind that has the potential to produce measurable results?	
Does the teacher present a detailed budget that is realistic and appropriate?	
Is the project cost-effective given the number of students impacted or the significance of the impact?	
Is the project addressing an issue in a creative or innovative way?	*
Will the project stimulate creativity or innovation in students?	*
Is there something about this project that makes it particularly special or compelling?
